SAFETY POLICY CHECKLIST

- 1. Is there a formal safety policy published?
- 2. Does your safety policy reflect organizational commitments regarding safety management?
- 3. Does your safety policy explicitly commit to reduce aviation risks as far as reasonably practical?
- 4. Does your safety policy include a clear statement about the provision of the necessary resources for the implementation of the safety policy?
- 5. Does your safety policy include the safety reporting procedures?
- 6. Does your safety policy clearly indicate which types of operational behaviours are unacceptable?
- 7. Are conditions where immunity is not granted (illegal activity, substance abuse, wilful negligence or misconduct) clearly stated in the safety policy?
- 8. Is your safety policy signed by top management (Accountable Executive)?
- 9. Is your safety policy communicated, with visible endorsement, throughout the organization?
- 10. Is your safety policy periodically reviewed to ensure it remains relevant and appropriate to the organization?
- 11. Does your safety policy confirm the intent to maintain or improve current safety performance?
- 12. Does your safety policy explicitly charge all employees with an obligation to actively support safety in their jobs?
- 13. Is your safety policy readily available to all employees? (easily accessible and in their languages).
- 14. Does your safety policy statement explicitly insist upon compliance with safety and operational standards?
- 15. Is your safety policy understood and accepted by all levels in the company?
- 16. Does your safety policy explicitly hold managers at all levels accountable for supporting the safety management system in their areas of responsibility?
